



Nymburk takes the U14 tournament triumph from Poland

The second tournament of the U14 category brought a series of close matches with each team claiming a win as well as a loss. However, the highest quality was shown by the boys from Nymburk, who deservedly took the gold.

The second stop of the U14 category came to the beautiful grounds in Wrocław, Poland. The tournament itself then brought a number of dramatic matches and sometimes some unexpected results. No one could be sure of the result before any match. After all, it was the first tournament of the competition this year, when all teams scored at least one win, as well as one defeat.

BA Nymburk showed the greatest quality thanks to the breadth of the squad, who deservedly went on to win the tournament. The second place was taken by the players of WKK Wrocław, who, although they are a year younger, still played good basketball.

In Sunday's fight for third place, the Slovakian team ŠBK Handlová turned around an unfavorably developing match against the Czech ADFORS Basket Litomyšl and rejoiced at the bronze medal.

The German team Thuringia Select Team and the Czech Levharti Chomutov finish in fifth and sixth position. Both teams scored one win, but the mutual duel was better for the team from Germany.
