



Žary the first winner in 2023

The third tournament in the U13 category was also the opening tournament of the new year and was hosted by the Czech town of Děčín. The only undefeated team that claimed the overall victory was the Polish team BC Swiss Krono Žary.

One would like to say, on the third attempt, the Polish team succeeded. Even in the previous two tournaments, BC Swiss Krono Žary was in the forefront and reached for victory, but it was only in Děčín that he achieved it, thanks to the fact that he was able to win in the dramatic match against the home team with a difference of only 2 points.

It was the only loss for the hosts and so the silver remained at home. The bronze bar goes to Germany to the winner of the opening HAKRO Merlins Crailsheim .

The boys from BK Brandýs nad Labem take fourth place ahead of another Czech team, Sokol Dubeč, who beat SKM Zastal Zielona Góra in an even match for the only place.

This tournament saw a lot of matches that ended with a significant difference in points, but this is a fairly expected phenomenon in the U13 category, and even so, the tournament certainly fulfilled its purpose for all participants.
