



WKK Wroclaw advances to the U15 finals undefeated

Even in their third tournament, the players of WKK Wroclaw managed to win without feeling defeated, and thanks to the balance of 15 wins and 0 losses, they are also the biggest favorites in the final final tournament, which will be hosted by Wroclaw.

The fourth tournament in Lučenec, Slovakia, concluded the basic phase of this season in the U15 category, which was dominated by the players of WKK Wroclaw. After this weekend, we already know everyone advancing to the final, which promises very balanced and dramatic matches.

But back to the final tournament, where it was a big fight for the medal positions. As already mentioned, the Polish team WKK Wroclaw managed to win all 5 matches and deservedly took the gold.

The teams in the second to fourth place scored the same 3-2 record when they managed to defeat each other. The ranking was decided by the score and thus the opening duel of the tournament, which was already played on Thursday evening. In it, the home team AKAPO Lučenec lost to PGE Spójnia Stargard by a high score of 29 points and this condemned the hosts to the 4th place and, on the other hand, secured the silver for the Polish team. BK VIVIDBOOKS Pardubice still fit between the two teams.

In a duel between two Slovak teams, the players of Slávia Trnava scored their first win of the season, MŠK BK Žiar nad Hronom by a single basket.
