



Stargard dominated for the second time, this time at home

The fourth tournament of the U14 category brought the teams to the Polish city of Stargard. And it was the hosts who clearly dominated all the matches in the tournament and deservedly rejoiced at the first place.

As in Brandýs, the PGE Spójnia Stargard team left no one in doubt as to who would take the top spot in their second tournament. In addition, the Polish team was able to enjoy the victory in front of the home audience. The final record of 5-0 with a score of 419:231 speaks for itself.

The first place was clear, but the big drama took place over other medal positions. Three teams finished the tournament with a 3-2 record, and the final standings had to be decided by a mini-table from their matches.

In the end, even the second place remained in Poland, specifically with the NBA Jelenia Góra . The bronze goes to Germany for Thuringia Select Team . In the end, the Czech team BK Teplice had the worst score from these mutual matches, which was left with an unpopular fourth place.

In the duel for the only victory in the tournament, the German team UBC Münster finally succeeded, which in the end overpowered SKM Zastal Zielona Góra in an even match.
